SPONSORS

Applicants are required to obtain to letters of sponsorship. **The letters must be on the sponsor’s business letterhead, dated, signed by the sponsor and included with the application, otherwise the application will not be processed or reviewed.** Sponsoring physicians must be well acquainted with your current professional activities. Letters should detail accomplishments of distinction by the candidate such as industry positions held, educational and publishing activity, and industry leadership.

Please list 2 AAIM Medical Directors who are submitting letters of reference for you.

PROCESS

- Application including demographic information and work experience
- Application fee, amount \$200, non-refundable
- Letters of recommendation- 2 from non-related companies, preferably from other FAAIM members
- Completed applications must be received by April 30 in order to be considered for that calendar year.

APPROVAL PROCESS

- Preliminary screening by AAIM Nominating Committee
- Approval by the Executive Council
- Approval by attendees at annual AAIM business meeting
- Under special circumstances, the designation of Fellow AAIM may be awarded at the recommendation of the current president of AAIM with unanimous approval by the Nominating Committee and approval by 2/3 of the Executive Council

DESIGNATION

The approved candidates are considered to be a “Fellow of the American Academy of Insurance Medicine” and are entitled to the designation of FAAIM. The right to include the initials FAAIM among your credentials lets your colleagues and coworkers know that you have met the high standards required for fellowship designation in the national organization of insurance professionals.
